This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 14, 1952, in which you raised a question as to your status under the terms of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended.

You advised that in November, 1951, you went to Israel as a guest of the Government of Israel. You also state, however, that during the trip to Israel you did not publish or transmit to the United States any documents or propaganda material.

In view of your statement, you were not acting within the United States as an agent of a foreign principal and, therefore, your registration under the Statute is not required.
