I regret the delay in replying to your letters of March 16 and April 28, 1964, addressed to Mr. Nathan B. Lenvin and Mr. James L. Weldon, Jr., respectively, in which you request the Department's view regarding your suggestion that the American Zionist Council submit a detailed statement of expenditures of its Department of Information and Public Relations for a sample period of three months only which, however, you believe would be representative of the expenditures for the entire period for which registration has been requested under the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended.

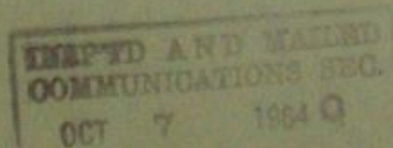
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While we have endeavored to make our requests as reasonable as possible, we cannot accept your suggestion since the information offered is not in compliance with the Act or what we thought our understanding was with Judge Rifkind.
