Gentlemen:

At the outset I should like to refer you to my letters of February 13, 1951 and April 10, 1951, in which I advised you of my receipts and expenses in connection with personal services rendered to the Government of Israel prior to February 14, 1951.

Following that date I took a position with the American Zionist Council. That appointment expired in October 1951.

In November 1951, I went with my wife to Israel as guests of the Government of Israel. I was not an employee of the Government of Israel. However, the Government of Israel did pay for my passage and also a sum to cover expenses, amounting to approximately \$2518.00, calculating Israel pounds at the tourist rate.

During this trip to Israel, I did not publish or transmit to the United States any documents, printed or propaganda material, whatever.

In January 1952, after returning from my trip to Israel, I again reverted to the American Zionist Council where I am presently employed.

I do not believe this is required to be filed under the Foreign Agents Registration Act, but am submitting this information to you to avoid any possible question.
