# Argentina Publishes Online Archive of Nazi-Era and Cold War Documents

Bias Comparison

- Right-Leaning outlets framed the document release as a direct accomplishment of Javier Milei, emphasizing his action of "declassifying" the files and portraying it as a move towards transparency, while left-leaning headlines focused on the disturbing content of the files, such as "secret activities" and the horrific actions of individuals like the "doctor who threw live newborns into the fire.
- The right de-emphasized details about other Nazi figures and Argentinian security forces assisting Mossad, instead highlighting Mengele's personal life in [Argentina](#) and quoting Argentine Chief of Staff Guillermo Francos.
- Though both sides acknowledged the Simon Wiesenthal Center's commendation, the emotional tone diverged sharply, with the left evoking strong moral condemnation through graphic descriptions, while the right maintained a more detached, fact-oriented approach centered on Milei's role.
- This divergence underscores differing priorities: accountability for historical atrocities versus celebrating actions by right-leaning figures.
