Submit a Request

The Department of Treasury allows the public to submit FOIA and Privacy Act requests electronically. There are two methods available for requestors wanting

to submit an electronic FOIA request to the Department of Treasury.

1. USE THE NATIONAL FOIA PORTAL

The National FOIA Portal can help you determine if filing a FOIA request is the best option for you and help you create your request when you're ready. This site allows requestors to submit their requests electronically through the government-wide portal at [foia.gov](https://www.foia.gov).

2. SUBMIT DIRECTLY TO THE BUREAU

If you wish to submit your electronic FOIA request directly to a specific bureau, then you may select the bureau from below and proceed with submitting your FOIA request.
